


Value Dimensions

 INTRINSIC The value of 'nature in itself' - regardless human utility (ecosystem health, ecological functions, biodiversity)


 INSTRUMENTAL The values of ecosystem goods and services (food and water production, regulation of water, air and soil, recreation, ..)


1. RELATIONAL The value of nature-human relations
