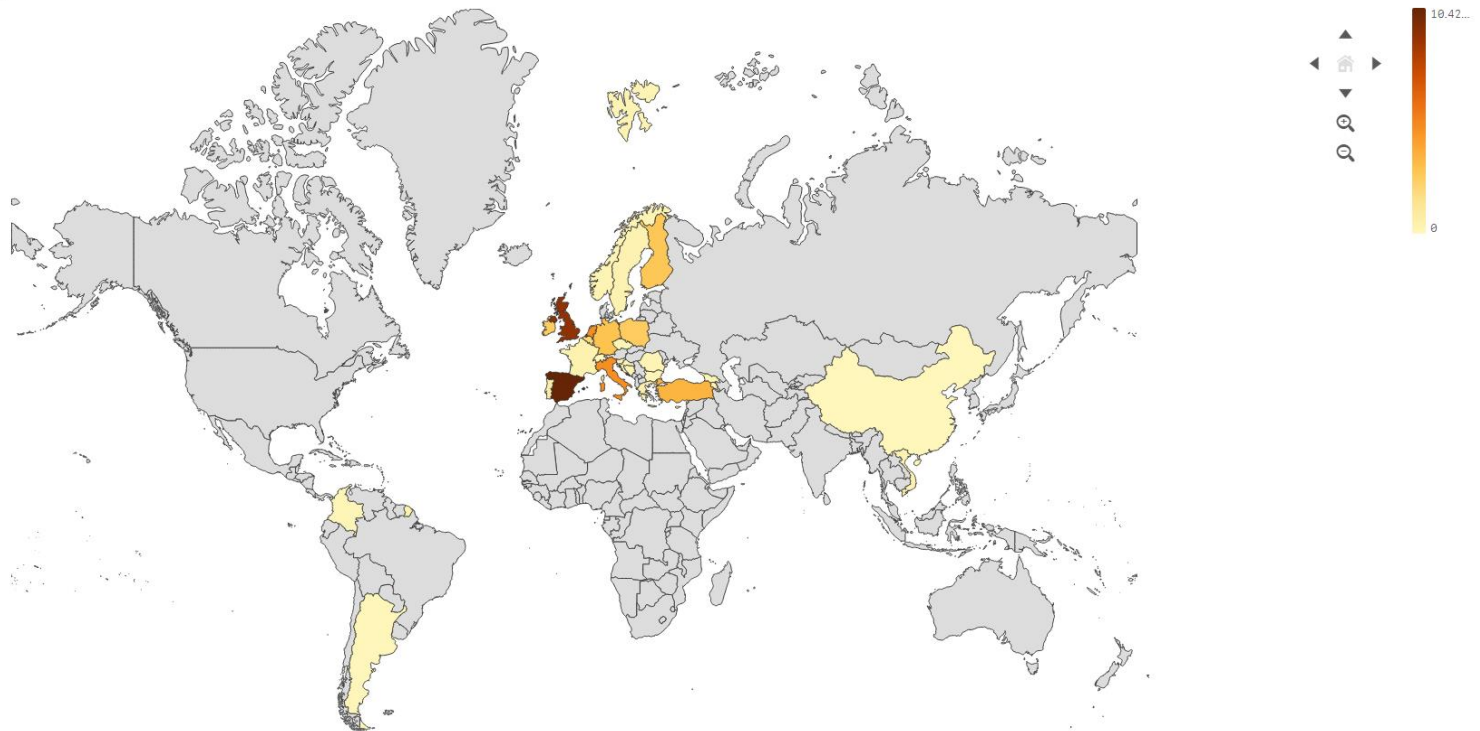
Impact indicators for NBS

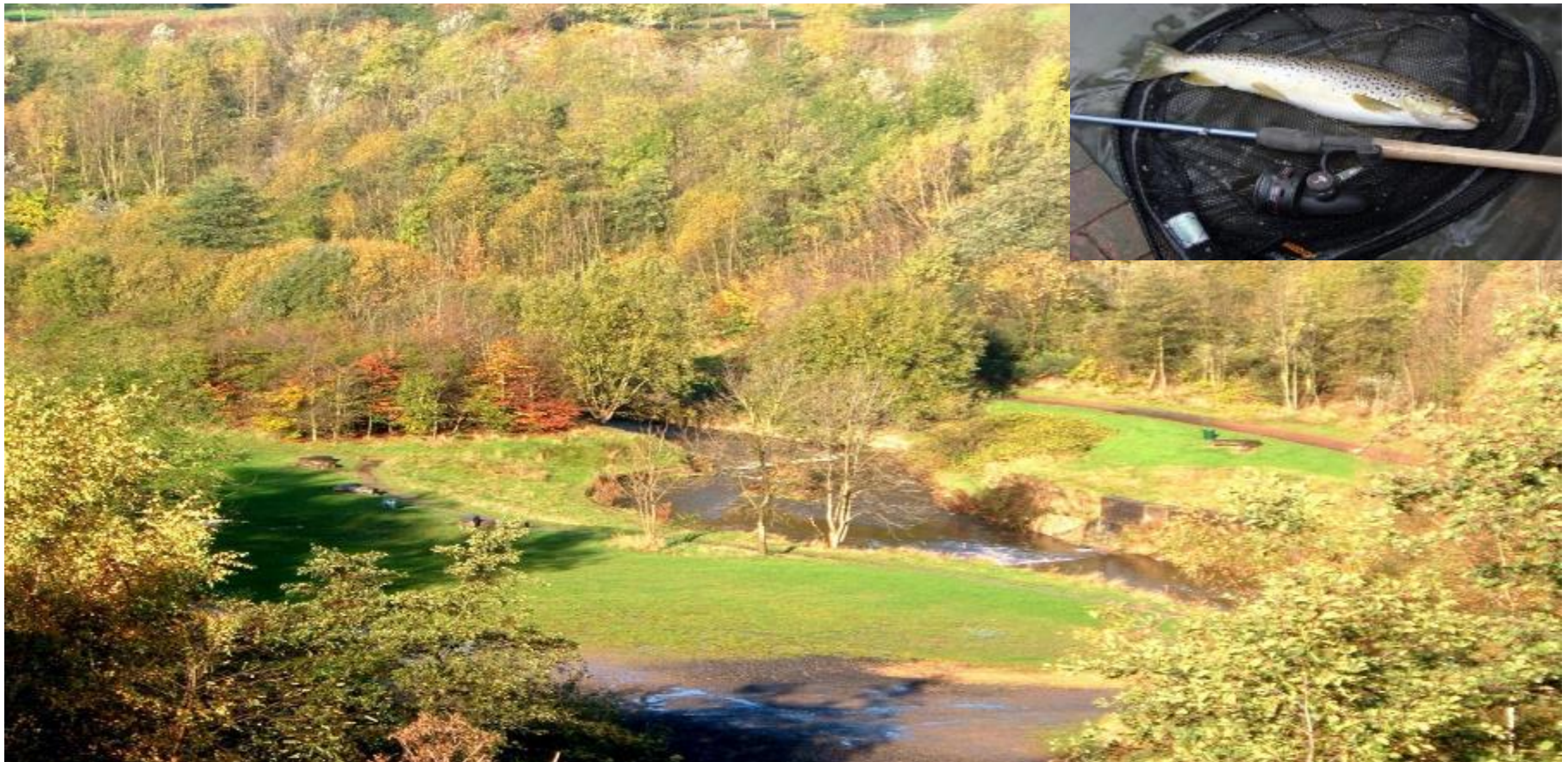

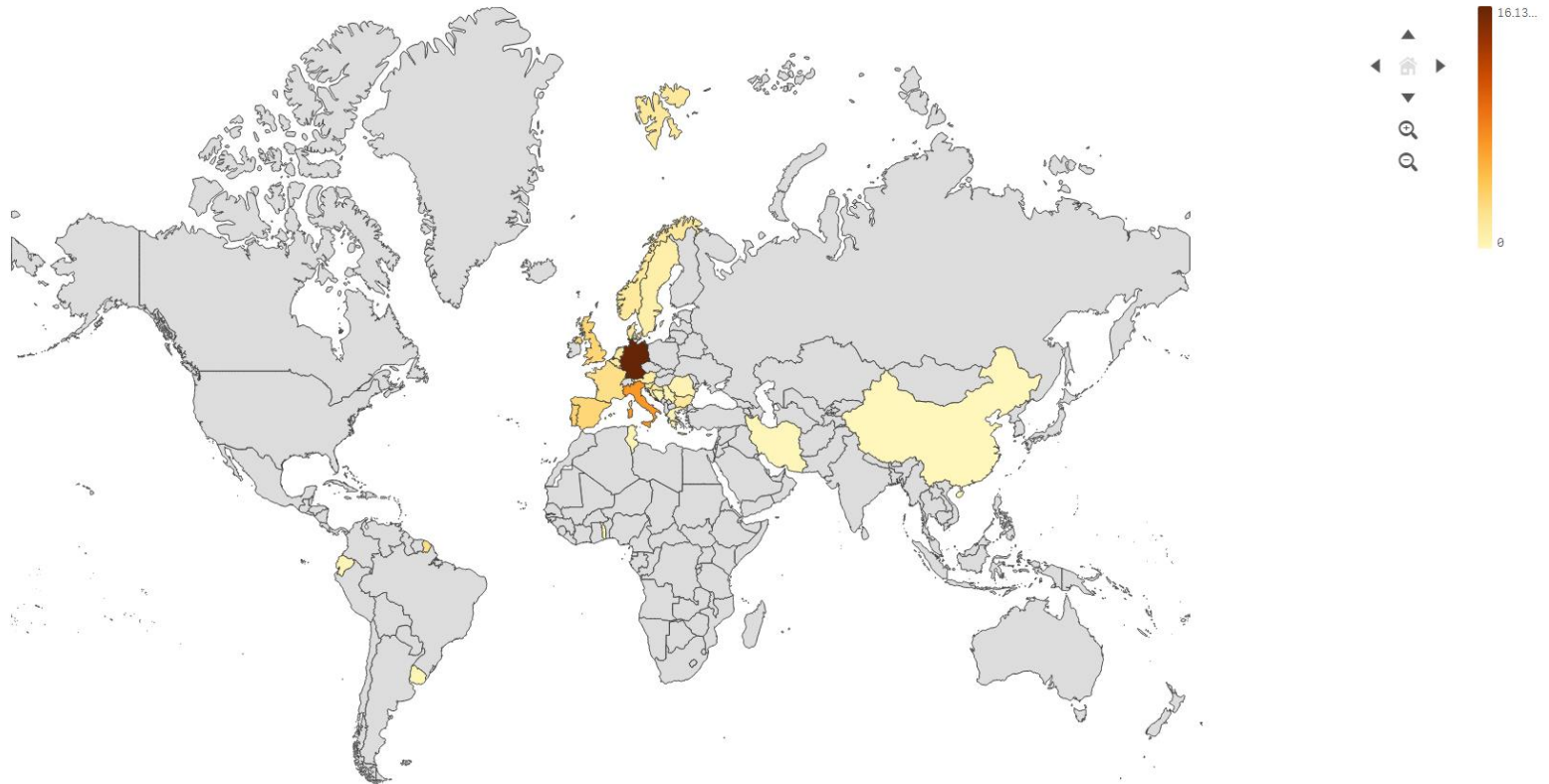


The same area today – NBS success story

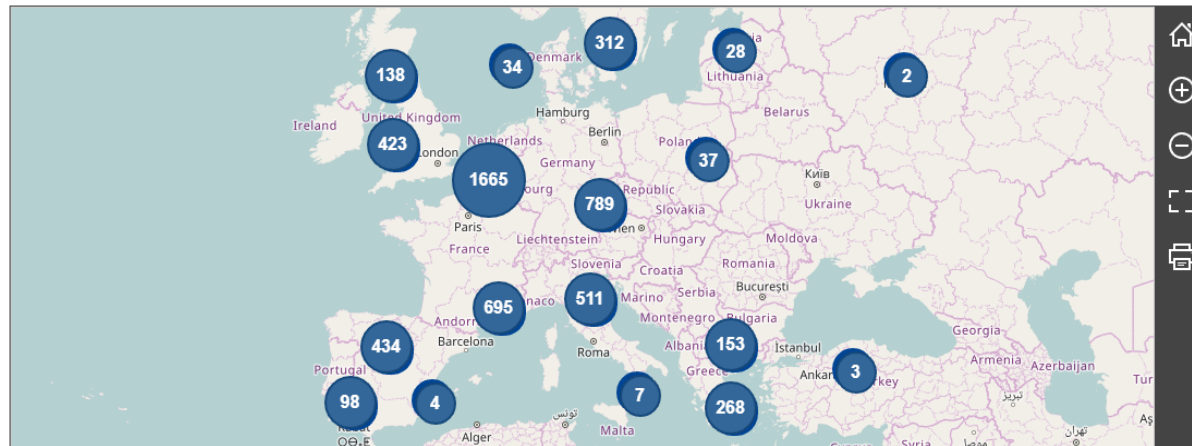
